

The residents of Kadantala and Urtasa village are mostly cultivators and fishermen who depend upon the forest and sea to fulfil their daily needs. In villages none of the houses are thatched roofs made of bamboo thatch and ^{timbers} ~~plywood~~ for the purpose of which they have to go to forest. Likewise their food habits mostly depend upon the species of fishes available at their nearby bays and sea.

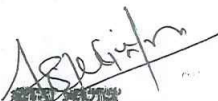
In case of implementation of PAT regulation and the relevant Act on the villages found at sea and forest there is all possible chance and threat that it may cause commotion amongst the general public which can lead to agitation in the locality.

7. The PS is the single marine police station situated at Kadantala. The western coast of the PS jurisdiction is poaching zone by the foreign poachers like Myanmar and Bangladeshis. During the year from 2002 to 2012, a total of 11 cases were registered under Foreigners Act.

8. The team of Directorate of Tribal Welfare should visit the settlement area to assess the real situation and to get public opinion.
