

- (v) Similarly at Kadamtala also Buffer Zone boundaries can be identified on the western side of the village with road / footpath constructed at the end of the paddy fields as distinct features in the village maps for reference.
- (vi) Buffer area in the Eastern side of the islands particularly the Shoal Bay creeks covering Kyd Island extending up to the Middle Strait entry point could also be excluded from the Buffer Zone.
- (vii) The entire Phooltala village near Kadamtala is to be kept within Buffer Zone area as this area is interactive point. Baring this and 6 villages mentioned in point No. iii above all the remaining villages of South Andaman & Middle Andaman can be excluded from this Buffer Zone including Baratang Island which is separated by a creek having a width of 500 meters or so.
- (viii) Buffer Zone on the western side of the Jarawa Reserve area in the sea is of no use as the Jarawa Tribe fishing activities are confined the shallow water and they hardly go beyond 500 mtrs.
- (ix) The Committee also feels that the fishermen of the area need a passage to go western side of the sea for fishing activities.

(x) The Field officials of AAJVS should be made responsible for reporting any violations to the nearest Police Station / Outposts, Forest Department and the law enforcing agencies to investigate the matter expeditiously and take action according to Law.
