5. The sources of drinking water of the JPP i.e. water coming from the natural nallah from nearby jungle is reportedly almost exhausted. The drinking water is to be arranged for the staff living in the JPP. Apart from above, the local Police conducting checking of passengers at Jaroda Kalan and Dharuni Khari Junction by placing barricades were found alert. However, they have also been briefed and directed not to allow any tourists to proceed to Jirkatang.
