

4. **Parash Nagar** is a revenue settlement village with an area of 185.34 Hectr out of which an area of 89.0 hectares was under Buffer Zone prior to 2012 Notification. The total population of the village is 520 out of which 218 population was covered under the Buffer Zone area before the revised Notification of 2012.

The village was settled by the A & N Administration during the year 1972 and the settlers are from Erstwhile Pakistan now Bangla Desh under the rehabilitation scheme of Govt. of India.

Most of the villagers are agrarian and agriculture is the main livelihood activity. The Administration is extended facilities like road, electricity, water supply and health facilities, education in the villages.
