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Most of the villagers are agrarian and agriculture is the main livelihood activity. The Administration is extended facilities like road, electricity, water supply and health facilities, education in the villages. Small petty businesses like tea-stall, ration shops, and grocery shops are in these villages. Presently there is no tourist establishment in the village.

23. Caddlegunj is a revenue settlement village with an area of 364.67 Hectr. The full village was under Buffer Zone prior to 2012 Notification. A population of 850 was covered under the Buffer Zone area before the revised Notification of 2012.

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24. Tirur is a revenue settlement village with an area of 84.33 Hectr. The full village was under Buffer Zone prior to 2012 Notification. A population of 230 was covered under the Buffer Zone area before the revised Notification of 2012.

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25. Herpartabad is a revenue settlement village with an area of 89.58 Hectr. The full village was under Buffer Zone prior to 2012 Notification. A population of 370 was covered under the Buffer Zone area before the revised Notification of 2012.

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
