

30. Tushnabad is a revenue settlement village with an area of 262.27 Hectr out of which an area of 152 hectares was under Buffer Zone prior to 2012 Notification. The total population of the village is 1320 out of which 1190 population was covered under the Buffer Zone area before the revised Notification of 2012.

The village was settled by the A & N Administration during the year 1962 and the settlers are the descendants of convict families i.e Pre-1942.

Most of the villagers are agrarian and agriculture is the main livelihood activity. The Administration is extended facilities like road, electricity, water supply and health facilities, education in the villages. Small petty businesses like tea-stall, ration shops, and grocery shops are in these villages. Presently there is no tourist establishment in the village.
