Administration has already taken up research
Project, to study livelihood pattern, health
issues etc of the Jarawas so as to assess the
perception, the will & the preparedness of the
tribe to interact with the outside world on an
equal footing and make informed decisions.
This work is being carried out with the
assistance of staff and officers of AAJVS. It is
expected that the report of the group will be
made available within six months.
