Dr Vishvajit Pandya, well known Anthropologist, Shri Kanchan Mukhopadaya Superintending Anthropologist, ASI. Kolkata and the other experts' alongwith AAJVS staff participated. The research work will be carried out by AAJVS under the guidance of the Group of Experts and the same will be completed by the end of November, 2013.
