That it is submitted that following complete ban of the ATR by the tourists for visiting Baratang islands, the livelihood activities of sizeable local population engaged in tourism activities have come to halt/ stand still. In this regard, it is submitted that the tourism activities in the A&N Islands has grown in the recent areas, and it is not only restricted to Port Blair but also other islands/ places namely Baratang, Uttara, Yerata, ~~Cut Bay~~ ^{Cut Bay} Beach, Aamkunj, ~~Cut Bay~~ ^{Cut Bay} Beach, Karmatang, Laljee Bay, Avis Island ~~in the Middle Andaman~~, Kalipur, Ramnagar, Sand bar joining Ross & Smith islands, Saddle ~~pick~~ ^{Peak}, ~~Kalighat~~ ^{etc.}, ~~Parangana etc in the North Andaman~~, where the tourists visit using ATR passing through the Jarawa reserve. Although travel on ATR through the Jarawa reserve was being monitored by convoy system and no vehicle was allowed/
