In the matter relating to SLP (C) No. 12125/2010 titled Lt

Governor, A&N Administration & Ors vs M/s Barefoot Inns & Leisure Pvt

Ltd, Hon'ble Supreme Court after hearing on 21.1.2013 has directed that

no tourist should enter in the ATR. However, the people living in

settlement villages and in islands, Govt officials, persons engaged in

providing essential services may continue to use the ATR. The court has

directed that an affidavit should be filed by the Admn within two weeks

alongwith proper sketch of the buffer zone in terms of the Notification

dated 17.1.13. It is also mentioned in the communication that the

movement of tourists through the ATR should cease forthwith and the

entry and exist of persons permitted to enter the ATR in terms of the SC

order be properly regulated and documented and also requested to ensure

strict compliance of the Court order in letter and spirit to avoid adverse

fallouts. The journal order of the Court is attached

Accordingly, Chief Secretary held a meeting on 24.1.2013 with

senior officers of the Administration for implementing the order of the

Supreme Court. The Hon'ble Lt Governor also discussed the issue and

directed to issue Press release for the information of general public.
