

The operators also requested to consider alternate route for conducting tour operations for their tourists in Baratang Lime Stone Cave and they also suggested increasing trips of ferry for Havelock, availability of more tickets/shows of Light & Sound shows at Cellular Jail and also increasing tickets for Jolly Buoy, so that more tourist can visit these touring destinations easily.

DC/SA welcomed their suggestions and assured them to take up these points with the administration for consideration.

At the end DC/SA explained that the administration is also very much concerned about the livelihood of the people connected with tourism in these islands, but compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court Orders is also mandatory for the implementing/enforcing agencies.

Once again SP(D)SA as well as DC/SA urged their cooperation in the implementation of the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court till arrival of final orders, which is fixed for hearing on 26/02/2013. All the Tour operators present in the meeting agreed and assured to give their full co-operation and help in implementing the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and assured of not using the ATR for tourism purposes until further orders.
