Clarification about use of ATR -reg.

Sir,

Sub:

In the interim order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the SLP No. 12125 of 2010 dated 21/01/2013(copy enclosed), the Hon'ble Court has allowed entry of the government officials and the persons who are settled within the Reserved area. The movement of vehicles required for transportation of essential commodities meant for Jarawa Tribe and other communities living in the Reserved area are also permitted. However, the court has ordered that no private individual or tourist shall be allowed to pass through the road by using vehicles or otherwise for going to the caves.

Therefore it may be clarified apart from tourists, which private individuals are not allowed to use ATR passing through Jarawa Reserve Area. Since the Court order is also silent about friends and relatives of the persons settled in the North & Middle Andaman District, this may also be clarified. An early reply in this regard will be highly appreciated.
