Minutes of the meeting held at J.P.P Jirkatang No: 2 on 02/02/2013 t review the Convoy system and to implement directions passed by th Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding restriction on movement (tourists on the ATR passing through Jarawa reserve area.

On 21st January, 2013, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Speci-Leave Petition bearing No. 12125 of 2010 passed interim order directing that r tourists should use the Andaman Trunk Road till next date of hearing i.e 26t February, 2013. The Andaman Trunk Road could only be used by the peop residing in the settlement villages, Govt. Officials and other bonafide road user including those who transport goods and services to the settlement villages in th North and Middle Andaman District.

In view of the above directions, the movement of tourists from Jirkatar area has been stopped w.e.f. 26/01/2012 and the directions of the Hon'b Supreme Court of India have been strictly implemented. Subsequently a meetir was convened at J.P.F Jirkatang No: 2 on 02/02/13 with the officers of A& Police to review the Convoy system and to implement directions passed by th Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding restriction on movement of tourists of the ATR passing through Jarawa reserve area.
