

Agenda Points

1. SP(D)SA inspected JPP Jirkatang and checked the present procedures in action to screen the Islanders from the tourists. The performance of newly installed CCTV cameras and quality of footage was also checked. In Cam 3 footage the number plates of the buses were not found to be clearly visible, hence R.T 109 Abdul Rashid was directed to further zoom and focus the camera on the number plate. Further R.T 109 Abdul Rashid was asked to check the availability of license plate Reader Camera (LPRC) from the local market.

(Action: R.T 109 Abdul Rashid)

2. The board placed at JPP Jirkatang indicating the timings of the Convoy was found faded and not clearly visible. In this regard, I/c JPP Jirkatang was directed to replace the board with a flex board display, clearly indicating the timings of the Convoy and further directed DySP(Traffic) to get the JPP building and campus white washed.

(Action: DySP/MA, DySP/Traffic & I/c JPP Jirkatang)

3. On inspection of registers, all the entries were found made in the same register. I/c JPP Jirkatang was asked to make separate registers for Govt. officials, residents, vehicles carrying essential commodities and passenger buses. Format of the registers have already been finalized and directed DySP(Traffic) to get the registers printed at the earliest. Further I/c JPP Jirkatang that was told that registers are being provided for making separate entries of passengers of Govt. and private buses. Entries of all the passengers travelling by Govt/Pvt buses are to be made in the separate registers compulsorily.

(Action: : DySP/MA, SHO Bambooflat, I/c JPP Jirkatang)

4. The booth, where the entries in registers are made was found to have insufficient space for the staff. Hence SHO PS Bambooflat was directed to place 02 tables and chairs in the parking area for making separate entries in registers regarding additional passengers travelling by Govt/Pvt buses.

(Action: SHO Bambooflat)

5. SP(D)SA directed I/c JPP Jirkatang to make separate queues for LMVs and HGVs. The LMVs would be parked in front of the existing booth i.e on the left side of the road and the drivers and passengers of the vehicle will register their entries in the existing booth. The buses and other heavy vehicles will be parked on the right side of the road in front of the parking
