place and the driver & passengers will register their entries in the parking place, where two police personnel will be making entries separately for Govt/Pvt buses. The buses will then be parked inside the barricading area and the passengers will be counted and boarded in the buses before departure of convoy from JPP Jirkatang.

(Action: : DySP/MA, SHO Bambooflat, I/c JPP Jirkatang)

6. The following Police Personnel were found to be making entries in the registers:

- a) PC/721 Sarvanan.
- b) PC/1071 Mohd Easheer
- c) PC/2338 Suresh lall
- d) CT/029 Sajan

SP(D)SA called all the above Police Personnel and checked their handwriting, which was found to be legible and satisfactory. I/c JPP Jirkatang was asked to continue to utilize their services in the same manner for making entries in the registers.

SP(D)SA directed Dy.S.P(Security) to install 02 CCTV Cameras in the parking area behind the Police desk to have the full and close-up view of the passengers and drivers furnishing their details to the police personnel, so that the person could be recognized/identified through CCTV footage if required.

SP(D)SA directed R.T 109 Abdul Rashid, Security Cell to record the movement of vehicles and passengers from 0500 hrs to 1630 hrs and to make soft copies of the recordings which has to be handed over to SP(D)SA weekly. (Order No 131 dated 31/01/12 was partially modified and R.T 139 Vimal Karunanidhi of PRO Unit and R.T 109 Abdul Rashid are being assigned the work for the maintenance/monitoring of the CCTV cameras at JPP Jirkatang).

9. In the meantime the buses proceeding towards Port Blair arrived at JPP Jirkatang from Middle Strait. SP(D)SA called the bus drivers whose details are as follows.
