- e) To give them medical aids when they come out for the same only to the extent it is necessary and in the event one is required to be hospitalised, to segregate him totally from other patients by keeping him in a segregated area or ward.
- f) To undertake Periodical programmes to give medical aids to the Jarawas only to the extent it is necessary in their own territory so that they need not come out on the open for receiving the same.
- g) To prevent contacts with the Jarawas by unauthorised persons.
- h) To take penal measures against the encroachers, poachers and who destroy the forest and also against the Police and civil administrative authorities who are negligent in taking steps against the poachers, encroachers and destroyers of forest.
- i) To form a high powered committee to monitor all the steps to be taken as mentioned above and to ensure such steps
