Minutes of meeting held in the Chamber of Secretary (TW) on 12/6/2006
to discuss about re-demarcation of Jarawa reserve areas

A list of Officers attending the above meeting is enclosed.

Forest department expressed that the re-demarcation of Jarawa reserve areas has to be carried out by revenue department and they will provide all necessary help as per the decision taken in the last meeting held on 5/5/2006.

After detailed deliberations on various related issues on re-demarcation of Jarawa reserve areas it was decided that:-

- 1) A team may be constituted comprising of Officials from revenue and Forest department under the leadership of Revenue Department
- 2) Forest department will provide GPS, labour and transport facilities to execute the above works
- 3) Revenue department will provide necessary concrete pillars for the re-demarcation works
- 4) The re-demarcation work should be started from Constant Bay, Tirur, Mile Tilak, Jirkatang, Shantanu, Kadamtala, Kaushalya Nagar, Chainpur and Hanspuri villages.
- 5) The re-demarcation works may be started before 22nd June 2006.
- 6) The progress of work will be reviewed after one month by the concerned Divisional Forest Officer, Superintendent of Police, Director (TW), Executive Secretary, AAJVS in the Chamber of Secretary (TW)
- 7) Considering the sensitiveness of the issue, it was decided that concerned Divisional Conservator of Forests and Divisional Forest Officer may attend the meeting instead of sending their representatives for taking immediate and effective action and issuance of directions to their subordinate Officials.
- 8) Executive Secretary, AAJVS will co-ordinate with both the department for completion of the work
