98 The proposal of the BBC not only involves prolonged interaction / stay of the documentary making team with Jarawas but the professional aspects including ethics. Therefore for consideration of such proposals, it is advisable to associate the concerned apex departments / organizations in the Administration as well as Government of India.

99 In this context Anthropological Survey of India having the national mandate for study / documentation of the scheduled tribes could be associated apart from the national Television (*Doordarshan*), Department of Information & Publicity in A & N Administration and AAJVS / Tribal Welfare Department.

100 The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India may take final decision in the matter keeping in view in the following, *inter alia*:-

- (i) Report / recommendation of the A&N Administration on the basis of scrutiny / comments of a Committee consisting of representatives of Anthropological Survey of India, *Doordarshan*, Information & Publicity, AAJVS/ Tribal Welfare Department.
- (ii) Revenue return / commercial aspects of the documentary film.
- (iii) Other terms and conditions for broadcast etc.
