Hence, I would like to propose to supply wooden cots made of paudak wood to tribal ward in all concerned hospital, specification and design as done by department carpenter is attached hereby.

I strongly believe that supplying wooden cots to tribal wards of hospital will minimize the expenditure and tribal patients will feel well being too.
