To prevent the open sky movement of non-tribal particularly tourist for the protection and welfare of the Jarawa and to stop the so called Jarawa tourisim a notification has been drafted declaring the existing belt of 30 metres from the central line on the either side of ATR as Reserved area (except at Nilambur - Middle Strait and Uttara -Gandhi Ghat where the existing Jetty and Port facilities) and the same has been circulated to the concern departments ie. PCCF, DGP, DC (SA), DC(N&M), Spl.Secy (Tourisim), Dir (IP) and to furnish the comments. After obtaining the ES, AAJVS comments/views of the departments the notification will be notified.
