

With regard to institutional arrangement to monitor the Jarawa Policy it is suggested that a High Power Committee consisting of Chief Secretary, A&N Administration as Chairman and the following departments viz. PCCF, DC (Andaman), DHS, CE, APWD, IGP, SP (District), DSS, Director, Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore and ES, AAJVS as members and Secretary (TW) as Member Secretary may be constituted to monitor implementation of the Jarawa policy at regular interval, say, once in three months.

The following departments viz. PCCF, DC (A), DSS, Police, APWD, DHS, AAJVS and Director, CIIL, Mysore concerning Jarawa Policy could be asked to come up with Action Plan in phased manner for implementation of the Jarawa Policy at the first meeting of the High Power Committee proposed to be constituted, for which a format has been devised and placed at page 33/c.
