As per policy on Jarwa Tribe of Andaman Islands published in A & N Gazette on 21st December, 2004, no person other than Jarwa is allowed to enter in the notified Jarwas reserved area by any means unless he/she is permitted by the competent authority designated by the A & N Administration.

It is therefore, requested that necessary action may kindly be taken on the matter at your end. However all efforts are being taken to strengthen the patrolling near the Jarwa reserved areas to prevent poaching and other illegal activities.
