Roy - for the added respondent The concern for the welfare of the Jarawa Tribe and their recent behaviour in coming out to the road and to ask for food from the passers-by sometimes even stopping their vehicles has prompted Miss Shyamali Ganguly, a learned Advocate of this court to move the present Public Interest Litigation. It will appear from the petition that the petitioner is concerned for the distressed condition of the Jarawa Tribe who according to her, are badly suffering from mal-nutrition and diseases and according to her, they are expressing their willingness to join the main stream. The petitioner complains that because of lack of proper steps which should have been taken by the Administration for the welfare of the Jarawas, the Jarawas come out of their forest to search for food and unless appropriate measures are taken immediately they might become beggars.
