The petitioner complains that although the Administration spend huge amount of money in the name of making contacts with the Jarwas, according to the petitioner, such trips were made for the reason of impressing the V.V.I.Ps and for their pleasure trips but no effective step was taken by the Administration for removing the difficulties of the Jarawas and to help them.

According to the petitioner, the Administration first of all failed to take sufficient protection to the Jarwas within their habitat and now they are out of such habitat for help and the Administration is not taking any effective steps in respect thereof. According to the petitioner when the said Andaman Trunk Road was constructed through the Jarwa area for the reason that the original tribe of Jarawa gradually would come in contact with the modern life and now that they themselves are coming out for search
