said Special Officer as it appeared to the Division Bench that the Special Officers were not even aware of the Master Plan and some of the suggestions and findings of the said Special Officers were wholly contrary to the said Master Plan. One of such examples is that the Special Officers found in the report that no problem was created for the Jarawas because of depletion of forest land which is wholly contrary to the said Master Plan.

Since going through such report, it appeared to the said Division Bench that such Master Plan has been prepared after detailed study by the experts, suggesting scientific remedial measures for the welfare of different tribes including Jarawas and the Administration therefore should take steps to implement such Master Plan, accordingly the Administration was directed to file an affidavit specifically indicating therein how the aforesaid Master Plan has been implemented by the Administration and in what manner giving detailed particulars as to what extent such Master plan has been implemented and what was still required to be done. The said Division Bench also expressed the view that it would also become necessary to make a scientific and proper study as to the cause and problems for which the Jarawas are
