(5) DUC is a D.O letter from the Secretary to GOI, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, New Delhi. Addressed to the Chief Secy. A&N Admin's regarding procurement and market Minor Forest Produce (MFP) and Surplus Agriculture Produce (SAP) by the State Tribal Development Cooperative corporations. They have stated that the main harvest procurement session for MFP & SAP is on. If organisations under State Govt. are informed of the commitment of TRIFED in this regard, TRIFED can work with organization and achieve the objective. They have asked our views on the subject.

In this connection if it may be mentioned that there is no Tribal Development Cooperative Corporations functioning in this UT for procurement and market MFP and SAP grown/collected by the Tribals.

There are following Scheduled

(7) Tribes viz. ① The Andamanis ② The Onkis, ③ The Jarawas, ④ ^{The} Sentinelese, ⑤ The Shompent and ⑥ The Nicobarise in the A&N Islands. Of these first five are primitive hunters and gatherers. As such there is no scope for purchase of minor forest produce from them.
