LG Writes To Union Agri. Minister

Minimum Support Price For Copra, Betel
Nut Produced By Nicobarese Urged

PORT BLAIR, JULY & Concerned by the lituation wherein tribal Nicobarese are not get; a remunerative prices or copra and betel nuts-these being their mail source of income and livelihood, the Lt. Governor, Shri. IP Gupta may written to the Union a griculture Minister, Shri. Nitish Kumar seeking his intervention for relaxing specifications for fixing minimum support price for copra and to implement Market Intervention Scheme for Betel Number both produced by Nicobari tribals in these island.

The Lt. Governor said that even if the minimum support price is least than the price already fixed by the Commission for Agricultural Cost and Prices, and the NAFE provides price support, it would help these tribals to a great extends their present economic condition is in dire strait.

Giving details about the state of affair with the Nicobarese, the Lindovernor said that ninery percent of the tribal population in Nicobareare dependent on coconut and betel nut plantation which is the livelihood. He said the price of copra and betel nut has fallen to such an extent that it cannot sustain the livelihood of a vast majority of tribals living in the southern group of islands of this U.T.

The A&N Administration had taken up the matter with the Ministry of Agriculture with the request to fix minimum support price for copra and issue directions to National Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED) for price support to the copra produced by the Nicobart tribals. However, the NAFED has declined to provide price support to copra produced by the Nicobarese on the ground that the (Contd.on page 4)
