

1. Increasing the quantum of MFP handled;
2. Strengthening the share capital base of the Corporation for undertaking MFP Operations thereby increasing the quantum of MFP presently handled;
3. Setting up of Scientific Warehousing facilities, wherever necessary;
4. Establishing processing industries for value addition with the objective of ensuring maximum returns on the MFPs for the tribals.
5. Giving consumption loans to tribals; and
6. Supplementing Research & Development (R&D) efforts.

The State Governments are required to forward the proposals alongwith

recommendations for release of funds under the Scheme. The following aspects have to be given due consideration for recommending any proposal for funding under the Scheme :
