Guidelines for the Selection of beneficiaries
and payment of subsidy for the construction of
B O A T

The guidelines/rules for the purpose of selection of beneficiaries for providing subsidy/financial assistance under the Scheme No.2 " Development of Capture Fisheries ".

1. The applicant should have the fishing and dinghi licences atleast for 3 (three) consecutive years including current year. In the case of tribes, they should be in possession of fishing licence for 2 consecutive years.
2. The Fishermen/tribes whom the boat was issued once on subsidy by the department will not be considered for further allotment/construction of boat for a period of 8 years.
3. When the Boat is purchased from Mainland:-

- (1) The applicant shall give the details of manufacturing cost of all the component of the boat and submit all the documents of manufacture/purchase of the boat.
- (2) The claim submitted by the applicant and the boat procured by him shall be verified and inspected by the Technical Staff of the Department to determine the factual accuracy of the application.

4. When the Boat is constructed locally:-

- (1) The applicant shall give the details of construction cost of boat (including materials) and tenders obtained by him if any.

After scrutinising all the applications shall be placed before the Selection Committee constituted by the A & N Administration for selection of beneficiaries for construction of boat.

6. Based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the approval for selection of beneficiaries shall be obtained from the A & N Administration.
7. Preference will be given to those who are members of fishermen Co-operative Society and in accordance to the duration of their engagement in fishing in the Islands.
8. Sympathetic consideration will be given to the case of affected fishermen by a natural calamity.
