Kindly refer to the letter No. 14-1/2001-2001-PL dated 6th September, 2000 (copy enclosed) of the Special Secretary (Planning), A & N Administration regarding the submission of the draft Plan Programme for 2001-2002. As you are aways the Tribal Sub-Plan, though a separate document is prepared containing the schemes to be implemented in the tribal area, is a part of the UT Plan as a whole, the exercise for formulation of Tribal Sub-Plan and UT Plan go together. Accordingly the draft Annual Tribal Sub-Plan, 2001-2002 corprising UT flow of funds and Special Central Assistance is required to be formulated alongwith the UT Plan. The guidelines issued for formulatio of UT plan by the Administration will apply to the Tribal Sub-Plan as well. The schemes under TSP funded from UT plan outlay and SCA will be on the sime pattern as the TSP for 2000-2001.

While reviewing the progress of implementation of TSP of various sectors from 19th to 22nd June 2000 for the year 2000-2001, the following deficiencies such as non - incluion of area-wise / Island - wise physical and financial targets under various sectors, continuation of redundant schemes under certain sectors, i.e., som of the schemes have been continued under TSP over the years, but those sciemes have not taken off. Such schemes need not to be continued under the annual TSP 2001-2002. In this connection your kind attention is invited to the minutes of the review meeting on implementation of TSP held if om 19th June to 22nd June, 2000 in the chamber of Director (TW), A & N Administration. Further while formulating the schemes, the Deputy Committee inscious issioner, Nicobars, who is the Chairman of Integrated Tribal Development Project (ITDP), Car-Nicobar may be consulted invariably to determine the priorities of the programmes to be included under Tribal Sub-Plan.
