

at the following places viz - (1) Car Nicobar (Arong); (2) Kamorta; & (3) Campbell Bay, the helpads at the following places viz. (1) Strait Island; (2) Kondul; (3) Pillo Millo; (4) Little Nicobar; & (5) Western Coast of Great Nicobar are also necessary. So atleast token provision may also be included under TSP, 2006-07. AE (Works) agreed to modify the schemes accordingly and submit to the Tribal Welfare Department latest by 24.2.06.

3. Education

The Assistant Director (Planning), Directorate of Education stated that as per the additional guidelines issued by the Planning Commission vide D.O. No. M-13054/2/2005-BC dated 29th December, 2005 of the Advisor, necessary provision has been included for payment of scholarship to the ST students from Class - I to Class X; reimbursement of tuition fee of ST students studying in private institutions including various professional colleges in the mainland; reimbursement of coaching fee for job training and for admission to professional courses. He also agreed to make provision for imparting coaching to the ST students after school hours in order to improve their standard. The Education Department proposed an outlay of Rs. 323 lakh out of the total outlay of Rs. 5,500 lakh, which constitutes 5.87 percent.

4. Information & Publicity

The Deputy Director (Tsm.) stated that the draft TSP for 2006-07 was yet to be approved by the concerned Secretary. However, he promised to send the schemes as soon as they are approved.

5. Social Welfare & Nutrition

The CDPO stated that the Social Welfare Department proposed to allocate an outlay of Rs. 24 lakh out of total outlay of Rs. 295 lakh for TSP, which constitutes 8.13% under sector "Social Welfare" while an outlay of Rs. 32 lakh out of the total outlay of Rs. 150 lakh under
