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contacts.

Owners and other personnel's of the licensed boats can be issued with the identity cards by the licensing authorities in the Administration and such information can be shared with the Police department to prevent poaching.

Research organizations like the Anthropological survey of India may carry out livelihood survey of the villagers.

**Legal and Governance Issues:**

- (29) It has been suggested that 'police officials sexually exploit Jarawa girls'. We would request the Sub-Group to give us specific details so that investigation can be taken up since no such cases have been reported so far with the A&N Administration.
- (30) & (31) It has been suggested that Jarawas should be 'included under the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution of India' and also to 'exclude them from the purview of other laws of the country'. This would require amendment to the basic major criminal and civil acts such as I.P.C, Cr.P.C, C.P.C., Evidence Act, etc. The views of the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Law & Justice should be obtained.
- (32) Hand out for do's and don'ts have already been developed by the Administration.
- (33) It has been suggested that VIP visits should be cleared with the prior permission of Cabinet Secretary. This requires clarification regarding the definition of VIP in the first place and under what articles of the Warrant of Precedence (WoP), persons should be categorized so as to have a clarity as to who is VIP or VVIP. Without such clarification, it would not be possible to have clarity on
