The Jarawa issue has today become an international issue. A number of organizations interested in the protection of indigenous populations are ready to help the cause of the Jarawas. Even the World Bank could be persuaded to take interest in the Jarawa affairs. Thus, in addition to funds made available by the Government of India, the funds for the construction of such a parallel ATR, outside the Jarawa Reserve in South Andaman could be constructed. It would, perhaps, serve as check and balance between the Jarawa and the outside world. In the meantime, government should formulate the positive strategies of interaction between the two.
