Alternative airstrip for Port Blair A&NI Admn	<p>Air connectivity for the public of Andaman and Nicobar Islands with Mainland is provided through operation of commercial flights in the Port Blair – Chennai/ Kolkata Sectors. The airport at Port Blair is used both by commercial flights as well as Defence Aircrafts of A & N Command. While the Airport Authority of India provides necessary facilities for operation of commercial flights, major portion of the land in the airport complex including runway as well as ATC operation is with the A & N Command. There being a hill at one end of the runway, the airport provides "uni-directional runway" with takeoff and landing from one end only.</p> <p>The Airport is situated in a "valley-like-formation" surrounded on three sides by hills with colonies and habitation on eastern and western sides. In the event of high intensity rain coupled with high tide the discharge of water is severely blocked, resulting in water logging on the runway endangering the safety of aircrafts and its operations. It is pertinent to mention that post –Mangalore Air-crash, the media had projected Port Blair Airport as one among top-ten dangerous Airports in India.</p> <p>Though the airport is declared as International Airport in 2008, additional infrastructure development for the airport is constrained due to lack of sufficient land in the airport complex.
