

(13) & (14) **Mobile health units and medical records for Jarawas :-**

The Directorate of Health Services has already constituted standing health team consisting of selected Doctors and para medical staff which would visit Jarawa areas periodically along with AAJVS workers who can communicate with the Jarawas. Health department may maintain detailed medical records of the Jarawas.

(15) **Medical Screening :-**

As provided in the notified Jarawa Policy also, the medical screening of the Personnel's of Police, AAJVS and APWD could be enforced with the help of Health department.

(16) **Precaution against spread of diseases :-**

Administration is not allowing the indiscriminate contact of outsiders with the Jarawas. The health department could monitor the health situation among the settlers of the villages near the Jarawa area.

(17) The impact of use of aluminum utensils on the health of the Jarawas could be studied by apex research Organizations like ICMR.

(19) **Removal of packaging materials:-**

As suggested by the Sub-Group, the packaging materials likes bags, cans, containers used for ATR maintenance can be removed from the Jarawa reserved by the construction agency i.e., APWD.
