Till such Regulation is enacted and promulgated, we appeal that the traditional tribal councils may be given status at par with the P.R.I's and recognized to be a body-corporate and self government units for the purpose of providing funds as provided by the Second Finance Commissions for this UT for the purpose of development works through self government institutions and aspirations of the tribals for under-taking need-based developments by these tribal councils are assured.

We shall be grateful if your appeal is considered realistically and with due perspective so that the constraints confronted by the tribal councils could be over come and they could be involved in implementing development process by devolution of suitable powers and financial support to implement the development projects for the tribals and consider these institutions as representative bodies for protection and welfare of the tribal interest.
