PUC is letter dated 17.7.2002 received from Assistant Secretary (Plg), A & N Administration conveying approval of the Outlay of the Planning Commission for 10<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan 2002-2007.

So far as the Tribal Welfare Department is concerned initially we proposed an outlay of Rs 503.25 lakh for 8 schemes under 10<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. Subsequently following the discussion held on 11.6.2002 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Lt. Governor the outlay in respect of sector - Welfare of SCs, STs & OBCs was revised to Rs.503.00 lakh. A new scheme namely Grant-in-aid to Tribal Councils in the Nicobar District has been included in the 10<sup>th</sup> Five Plan. In this connection please refer to notes at para 11-14/n at page-7/n. Accordingly, the 10<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan with an outlay for Rs. 503.00 lakh was sent to the Special Secretary (Plg) vide this office letter dated 11.6.2002 at page 9/c.

Now the Planning department vide their letter 17.7.2002 (PUC) has conveyed an approved outlay of Rs. 503.00 lakh for 9 schemes under 10<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. (Pl refer to P.137/c)
