

CIVIL SUPPLIES

Shri. Basu Kumar, Director explained in detail about the allocation and schemes and on going works.

Scheme No. 2:

The Director agreed to surrender Rs. 5 Lakhs from both the scheme.

Scheme No. 3:

Remaining schemes are passed.

Shri. Rajkumar Sharma, Member suggested to open FPS at places where people's accumulation is there. The Director intimated that the Gram Panchayats would select the place where FPS is to be opened and recommend the case. Accordingly, the Directorate will do.

COOPERATION

The RCS said that the new Scheme No. 12 has been included in the plan as "Assistance to Coop. Societies for Implementation of Price Support Scheme, Market Intervention Scheme and Improvement/Diversification of Plantation Produce". The RCS further stated in view of revised price support scheme, in expectation of introduction of MIS for arecanut as well as installation of copra driers, a minimum of Rs. 2 Crores would be required. **DPC deliberated on the issue and proposed additional Rs. 150 Lakhs under this sector. The total allotment will be Rs. 425 Lakhs.**

SURVEY & STATISTICS

The DPC passed the schemes as it is within the outlay suggested by Planning Branch.

JUDICIARY, JAIL & LABOUR WELFARE

The DPC passed the Schemes as it is within the outlay suggested by Planning Branch. However, the Jail Superintending has requested to provide an additional amount of Rs. 20 Lakhs which was agreed by the DPC.

SECRETARIAT ECONOMIC SERVICES

The DPC passed the Scheme within the outlay suggested by Planning.

ROAD TRANSPORT & CIVIL AVIATION

The Director agreed to keep Rs. 30 Lakhs for construction of Central Work Shop with store and work shop facilities instead of 40 lakhs. By which, Rs. 10 lakhs_will be surrendered. The Director also agreed to further surrender Rs. 2 lakhs from Scheme No. 5-computerization of Transport Department. (Page- No. S-17). Hence, the outlay for Annual Plan 2002-03 will be Rs. 188 Lakhs.
