

The Hon'ble MP stated that for creating awareness and preparing handbills in various languages such as Hindi, Bangla, Tamil & Telugu etc. regarding the facilities and benefit given by the department, a suitable provision should be kept and plans. Further, he added that hostel facilities for 75 students may be provided.

Scheme NO. 5 page AA-17

1 (a) In 2000-2001 the DPC decided to open 16 schools with computer education

Name of the school should be included in the Physical Target. The DPC also stressed that another 15 schools in the 10th Five Year Plan, the Scheme should be specified as allocation made in 10th plan

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Edn) said that at present computer education is imparted in 16 School in A & N Islands but it would be imparted in all the 43-Sr. Sec. Schools during 10th Five Year Plan

The Hon'ble MP suggested that all capital works should be brought into one single scheme and made following suggestions that

(i) Scheme NO. 6 & 11 Page AA- 20 & 35

Privatized & accordingly Administration did it.

Both the scheme deals with books, so the same should placed under one command. i.e. Library Services under ADE (Test Book)

(ii) Scheme No. 7 page AA-22

- 1 Token provision to be kept.
- 2 Some seats may be reserved in the Sainik School in the mainland & selection may be done on merit basis.

(iii) Scheme No. 8 Page AA - 25

- 1 Construction of Central Store building is not required.
- 2 Only furniture for students will be purchased.

(iv) Scheme No. 10 Page AA 32

1 The main thrust should be to propagate and make Hindi more popular.

Shri. Sanjeev Kumar, Secretary (LSG) stated that to promote Hindi language is basically meant for doing official works, writing files in Hindi and for creating related infrastructures and for this purpose we have kept Rs. 20 Lakhs per Annum.

(v) Scheme No. 13 Page AA- 32

1 Talented students (Music & Art) should be picked up from different islands and give them boarding and lodging at Port Blair and should be given admission in good school with special coaching and tuitions.

The Hon'ble MP stated that some provisions may be kept to impart training to these students at mainland. Further, he added that marine Swimming pool should be available in each Tehsil. He also stated that as per discussion held with the then Lt. Governor for Cricket Ground for which land was proposed at Nayagaon, action should be taken to implement the decision. Provision be kept for the purpose.
