

- 2 Construction of Science Centre (Page- AA-410 at Prot Blair and to organize various Science Centre. Grant in aid of 1 to 2 lakhs will be arranged by the MP.

(vi) Scheme No. 14 Page

- 1 Adequate provision for equality coaching to talented students at mainland and locally with all facilities including lodging and boarding is made.
- 2 They should not be any more Mini Stadium.
- 3 Construction of Bal Bhawan - token provision be provided.
- 4 Marine Swimming pool - At least 7 Nos should be constructed and shown in the physical target. Quality coaching to talented students at mainland may be kept.
- 5 Every year Subroto Mukherjee Sports Society organize 2 times in different places namely Bangalore, Jalandhar, Kolkata & Delhi in search of talented sports person, (football, Hockey, Cricket, Volley Ball, Cycling and 100 & 400 mtrs races) with minimum qualification 10th passed.

Sponsored such talented persons may be sent to mainland to participate provision may be kept.

(vii) Scheme No. 15 Page AA- 48

- 1 In the Physical Target stipend to hostellers not mentioned. Stipend should be given at the rate Polytechnic/ ITI. The Commissioner (Edn) agreed and stated that action is already on in this direction.

Amount should be mentioned. Financial provision has been kept.

(viii) Scheme No. 17 Page AA - 54 7 58

It has been seen that the Plan money is spent in creating infrastructure with out ensuring optimum use of existing infrastructures such as Building. Machinery equipments etc.

(ix) Scheme No 17 is an example of such activity.

The DPC pointed out that for student capacity of 60/80, expenditure to the tune of 2 Crores per Annum is very high.

Shri. Sher Singh, Member told that at present nearly Rs. 2 1/2 lakhs are incurred on a B.Ed student per year. Hence, he has reminded the house that he had made following suggestions during the last DPC Meeting, which are as under:-

- ❖ B. Ed and TTI should be clubbed together
- ❖ Or it should be shifted to JNRM
- ❖ Or the student should be sent to mainland for this course.

He is of the view that by doing this, the Administration can save a good quantum of money.

Shri, Marudhavanan agreed with the view of Shri. Sher Singh and said that all these colleges are affiliated with Pondicherry University. As such, he said that it can be easily shifted to JNRM. Further, he wanted to know

1. How many students are under going training every year,
2. How many have got employment and
3. How much expenditure is incurred by the B. Ed college yearly.
