

The Hon'ble MP added that a committee should be formed to study the reliability of this scheme. DPC recommends a committee be constituted consisting of --

- 1 Govt. Officers
- 2 PRIs Members
- 3 Educationist or persons who distinguished themselves in the area of education to study the issue and make suggestion on following: -

1. TTI/DIET to be clubbed with B. Ed College

- 2. To shift B. Ed. College to JNRM as Faculty of Education
- 3. Students of B. Ed College to be send for mainland for Higher Studies

The committee should be given 1 (one) month time to submit the report.

The Director of Education replied that the suggestion of DPC would be put before the appropriate authorities for necessary action.

POWER

Shri. Arun Goyal, Commn-cum-Secretary (Power) agreed to surrender Rs. 3.00 Crores. As such, the plan provision will be now as Rs. 32 Crores instead of Rs. 35 Crores.

Shri. Manohar Singh, Superintending Engineer (Ele. Dept) told that the survey is going on at Rangat Nallah, Panchavati Nallah and Korong Nallah for Hydel Power Projects.

The Hon'ble MP told that good water sources are available at Krishna Nallah at Little Andaman, Prem Bahadur Nallah and Swaroop Nallah of Great Nicobar. The survey of these Nallahs may also be done in order to tap the Hydel Power while doing survey the following information may also be incorporated with report.

- 1. Present Power Consumption.
- 2. 10th Plan total power requirement.
- 3. Power to be generated from particular scheme.

The Superintending Engineer, Electricity agreed for inclusion. To a question from Shri. A R Marudhavanan, Member, the Superintending Engineer informed one Micro Hydro Plant will be installed at Badakhari.

HEALTH

Smti. Namita Ali, DHS stated that in aggregate 8 schemes are there. Out of which 5 are continuing schemes and remaining 03 are new schemes.

Shri. Hemachandran, Commn-cum-Secretary (Health) informed that the total outlay for the year is Rs. 410 Crores for A & N Islands. Out of which, the Health Department has demanded for Rs. 2050 Lakhs, which is 5% of the total of the outlay. Meanwhile, as per All India Norms 12% is to be incurred on Health Services. Likewise during 9th FYP the total expenditure is 98 Crores, which is 5.57%. But now it has been further reduced to 5%. Hence, he has requested to enhance the funds.

The Hon'ble MP said that whatever projection was made by department; the same was agreed by Planning also. However, he said that already there is a Hospital ship namely MV Shompen with the
