## **LSG (MUNICIPAL COUNCIL & PANCHAYATS)**

The Secretary, Municipal Council told Port Blair Municipal Council explained in detail about all the new schemes taken by council and stated that out of projection of about 62 crores only 10.10 crores has been suggested by planning.

MP proposed for

1. Fishermen shed - 4 Nos.
2. Water Meter to each house.
3. Dhobi shed
4. Well - Repair (Water pump with filter)
5. Nayagaon & Anarkali Burning ghat/ Graveyard (Water facility, shed, electricity and fencing etc)
6. Creation of SE posts
7. Separate scheme for Education
8. C/o Balwadi Nursing Schools
9. C/o Anganwadi Schools
10. Housing in Port Blair for LIG and MIG other than EWS by tagging some agencies such as HUDCO.

The Hon'ble MP said that funds for beautification under Tourism Department could be taken for PBMC from next year or from this year

**The DPC agreed to enhance the total allocation of Municipal Council to Rs. 15 Crores.**

## **PRIs / ZILLA PARISHAD**

The Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad explained in details about new schemes incorporated in Annual Plan to PRIs. He stressed the need for fulfilling the demands projected by PRIs for Road, Water Supply and Education sector. The DPC deliberated the issue and agreed in principle to give funds to PRIs. But due to shortage of funds, **the DPC decided to increase the allotment as below: -**
