

5. Establishment of Vocational Training (for skills in computer operation & stenography) for tribals:

A outlay of Rs. 2.40 lakhs has been made for the annual plan 1999-2000 while we propose an outlay of Rs. 11.15 lakhs for the annual plan 2000-2001. There is increase of 464.58% over the outlay for the current financial year. A VTC in computer operation has been set up at Car-Nicobar. A batch of 20 tribals are to be enrolled for training in computer on payment of a stipend of Rs. 300/- pm. The centre is likely to start functioning during the current financial year. Sufficient numbers of computer are proposed to be procured and installed in the centre. Hence increase in the outlay.

6. Establishment of Ashrams at District and Towns level

A token provision of Rs. 5.00 lakhs is proposed for construction of an Ashram (guest house) at Kamorta under annual plan 2000-2001 while under the annual plan 1999-2000. A token provision of Rs. 1.00 lakh has been made. There is 500% increase in outlay over the current financial year. The land has been set apart. The Tribal Council, Kamorta has been requested to furnish the requirement of accommodations for the proposed Ashram building, but it is yet to be received.

There is overall increase of 248% in the outlay for 2000-2001 over the outlay for the current financial year.

If approved the schemes may be sent to the Planning Department. After the schemes have been approved by the Planning Department we may send a copy of the schemes to the Advisor (SD&WP), Planning Commission, New Delhi with reference to her letter dated 11.11.99 (PUC).
