1. Name of the Scheme: Grant of additional scholarship to tribal students for higher education.
2. Objective/Justification for 8th plan(1992-97): The scholarships are being paid at different rates to students for studies in the mainland, out of the Non-Plan budget of the Education Department. It is felt that the tribal students under-going higher education need to be given more assistance in the shape of scholarships for meeting the expenses in pursue their studies due to in-crease in the cost of living. In order to generate greater interest in the pursuit of higher education among tribal wards, it is proposed to grant additional scholarship @ Rs.150/- per month per student for higher/professional education in the mainland during the 8th plan.
