

TRIBAL WELFARE SECTION

(77) The members of the tribal council of Car-Nicobar handed over the physical position of the land bearing survey No.2542/4 area-3400 Sq.mtrs. situated at South Point to the Executive Engineer, Port Blair, North Division, APWD, Port Blair for construction of the Nicobarese Guest House today. During the inspection of of the site, the Chief Engineer, APWD pointed out that the APWD would require an amount of Rs.15.00 lakhs for construction of the Guest House during the current financial Year (1992-93) whereas a provision of Rs.5.00 lakhs is only available in the budget.

(78) In this connection, it may be mentioned that an amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs is provided under Major Head- '4059' (Plan), V.V.i, Capital outlay in Public Works, V.V.i, (i) General, V.V.i (i) Construction, V.V.i (i) (i) (4) Other Departments for construction of Nicobarese Guest House. This Head of Account is operated by APWD. Accordingly, the Executive Engineer, Port Blair, North Division may debit the expenditure against the above budget. In this connection, this Admn's Signal of even number dt.4.9.92 addressed to Shri Ibrahim Ali Hussain, Vice-Chief, Captain, Car-Nicobar and copy endorsed to the ~~Executive~~ Chief Engineer, APWD and Executive Engineer, PBND may be referred to.

(79) It has been informally clarified by the Accounts Officer (Fin) , A & N Administration that the Tribal Welfare Department cannot deposit fund with the APWD for undertaking construction of Nicobarese Guest House, as it is under the same Administration. Instead, the APWD could utilise the fund provided the relevant Head of Account for construction of the Guest House.

(80) As far additional fund of Rs.10.00 lakhs, the Chief Engineer, APWD may be requested to claim additional fund in the R.E under the above Head of Account for construction of the Nicobarese Guest House.
