has not provided any fund under the Annual Plan(1994-95) for construction of ~~the~~ 2nd phase of the Nicobarese Guest House. Perhaps, there seems to be no need for construction of any more accommodation for the ~~purpose of~~ Guest House as the existing building have adequate accommodation for the visiting Nicobarese. It consists of one dormitory, common ~~rest~~ Dining Hall, common Toilet, two separate rooms with attached Toilets and Kitchen on the ground floor and two dormitories with common toilet attached to each, two separate rooms with toilet attached to each on the first floor.

However, the APWD had submitted an estimate for Rs.3.61 lakhs for providing furnitures in the Nicobarese Guest House vide their letter dt.22.3.94 at page. 85/c. The estimate could not be sanctioned during the financial year 1993-94 as it was received very late i.e. in the last week of March, 94. Moreover, no fund was available during the financial year ¹⁹⁹³⁻⁹⁴ to meet the estimated cost of the furnitures. During the current financial year(1994-95) an amount of Rs. 0.43 lakhs has been provided for providing furnitures for the Nicobarese Guest House.
