except for providing accommodation to the watch and ward staff.

What is also required to be done is removing the structure of the old Guest House in front of the new building of the Guest House to provide easy access to the new building. The old building contained only one long-hall dormitory accommodation. Shri Ibrahim Ali Hussain, Vice-Chief Captain, Tribal Council, Car Nicobar was requested vide our reference dated 3.1.1994 (Page 81/c) by the Tribal Welfare Department to allow PWD to dismantle the old structure as requested by the PWD. No response has been received to the same. Again a fax message has been sent to the DC (Nicobars) to get the needful done so as to facilitate inauguration of the new building proposed on 14th August, 1994.

It is also worthwhile pointing out that the APWD was far exceeded the estimates orginally sanctioned by the Administration for the construction of the Nicobari Guest House in August 1992 although the revised estimates for the same are still awaited(Para 147/N). The Adiitional funds, if any, required for the purpose may have to be arranged by diversion of funds from some other Heads under the UT Plan to meet the excess expenditure incurred by the APWD so far for this project.
