3. The team should be escorted with AAJVS officials and Police Personnel. No member of the team shall interact with the Jarawa tribes during the course of work.

4. The team should complete research work before 2:00 PM and shall leave the Jarawa Reserve Area by availing last convoy.

5. They should deposit the mobile phone, or any camera with the Police Outpost, Jirkatang. No photography shall be allowed in the Jarawa Reserve Area. The team should ensure that no cigarette, alcohol, match box, lighter or any other inflammable articles shall be carried in the Jarawa Reserve Area
