Now the consultant Ms. Prajna Chowta has requested the permission of PCCF, ANI for shooting the documentary film in the Reserved Forest areas at Baratang, Kadamtala, Mayabudner, Diglipur and surroundings (Smith Island) and Havelock to process the permission with Ministry of Home Affairs and Ministry of External Affairs Govt. of India.

It is submitted that the Department of Environment & Forests have no objection to grant permission to shoot the documentary film.

However, since the documentary film shooting is carried out by a foreign film production company, the approval of the Chief Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Administration is solicited before granting permission to LES FILMS DICI, Paris, France to shoot the documentary film titled "Odyssey of the Andaman Elephants".
