PUC is an application received from Master Siddharth Singh Khirwar, Class XIth, Model School, Barakhamba, New Delhi regarding grant of permission to carry Research Project on Jarawa Tribe in A & N Islands for education purpose alongwith one Research guide available in ANTRI.

In this context, it is submitted that under Section 7 of the A & N Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956, the Deputy Commissioner of the District is the authority to consider the application for the Tribal Pass. Hence the tribal pass is to be obtained from the District Administration.

With regard to research project on Jarawa tribe, it is submitted that the said student is going to carry out the research under the guidance of Dr. Pronob Sircar, Tribal Welfare Officer recently posted at ANTRI. Hence we may convey no objection to the above said student on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Study should be carried out under the overall supervision of Executive Secretary, AAJVS
- 2. The outcome of the study should be shared with the ANTRI, so that it may help them to take appropriate actions in the field of education to Jarawa tribe
- 3. No undue interference in the lives of Jarawa tribes during the course of research work
- 4. Necessary statutory permits for entry into tribal reserve should be obtained from the District Administration.
